3.02 Create a New Registry Key and Value

Purpose

You can Create a New Registry Key and Value in [32 bit Operating system](#) and [64 bit Operating system](#) to disappear SAP menu item to avoid performing changes to the required menu items of the SAPGUI. You need to follow different path to create registry key and value in different types of Operating Systems.

Pre-requisites:

You need to have Administrative rights for the machine on which the task is to be performed.

User Interface

Steps to create a Registry Key (Administration) for 32Bit Operating System.

1. Click "**start**", type "**regedit**" in the search bar and then click "**enter**".

2. Navigate to the below specified path to create a registry key.

HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\\Software\\SAP\\SAPGUI Front\\SAP Frontend Se

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3. Right Click on **SAP Frontend Server**, select **New** and then **Key**.

4. You need to rename **New Key #1** to **Administration** as shown below.

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5. Right Click on **Administration** Key and select **New**, and then select **String Value**.

6. You need to rename **New Value #1** to **DisappearItems**.

Steps to create a Registry Key (Administration) for 64Bit Operating System.

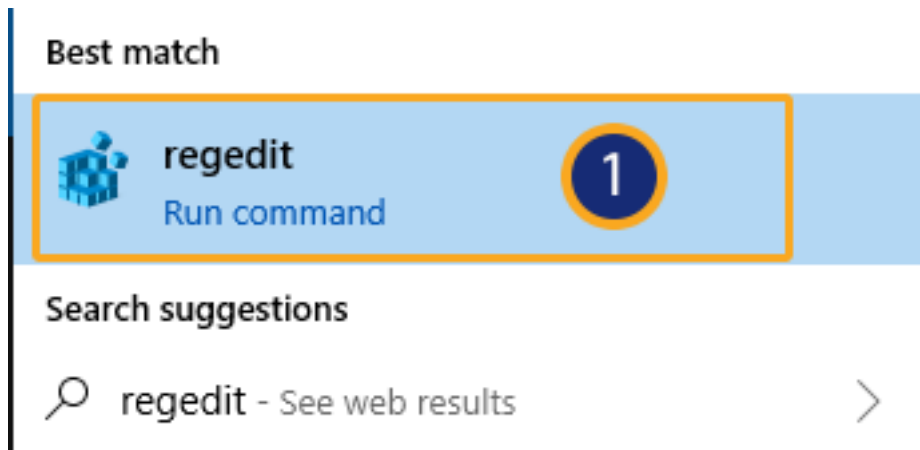
1. Click **Start** and type "**regedit**" in the search bar and hit "enter".

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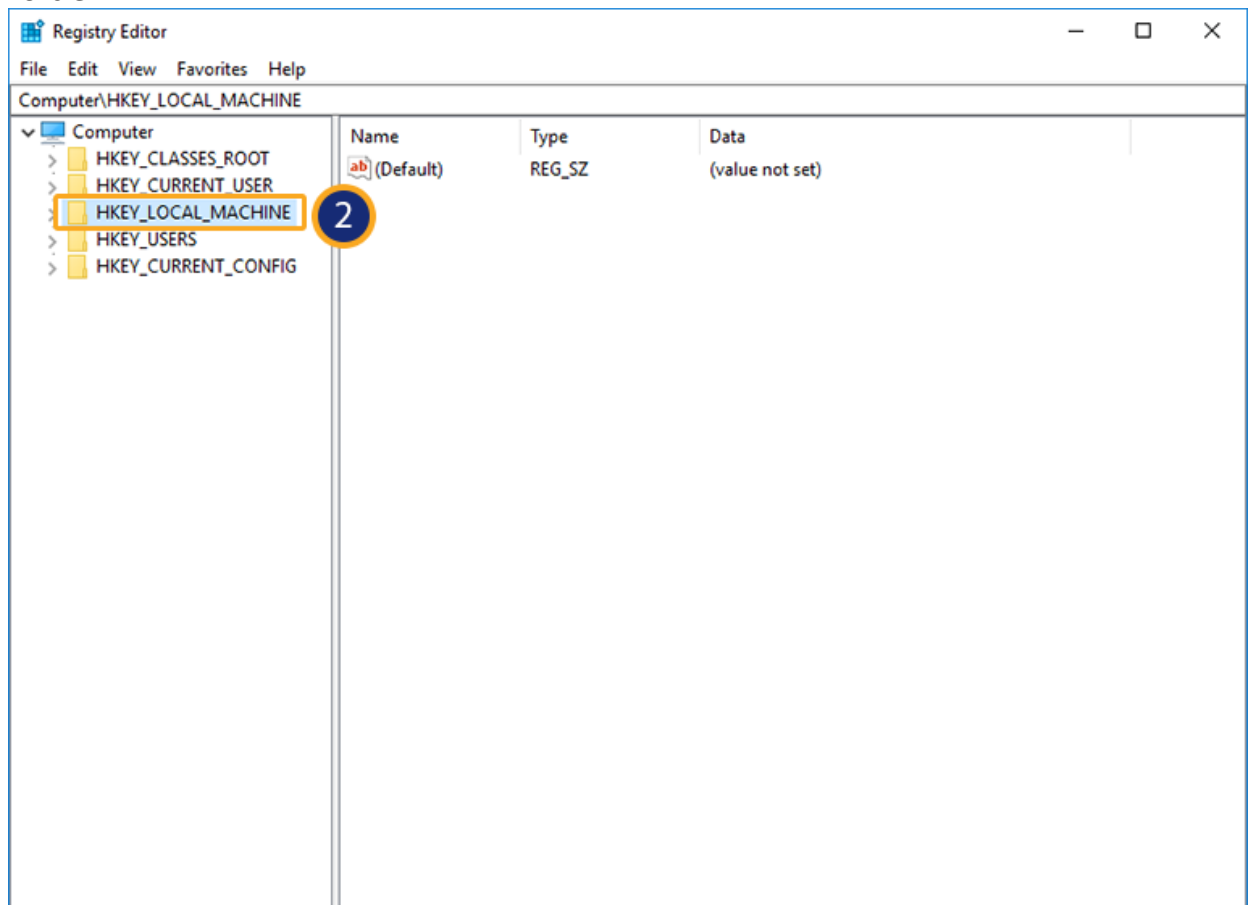

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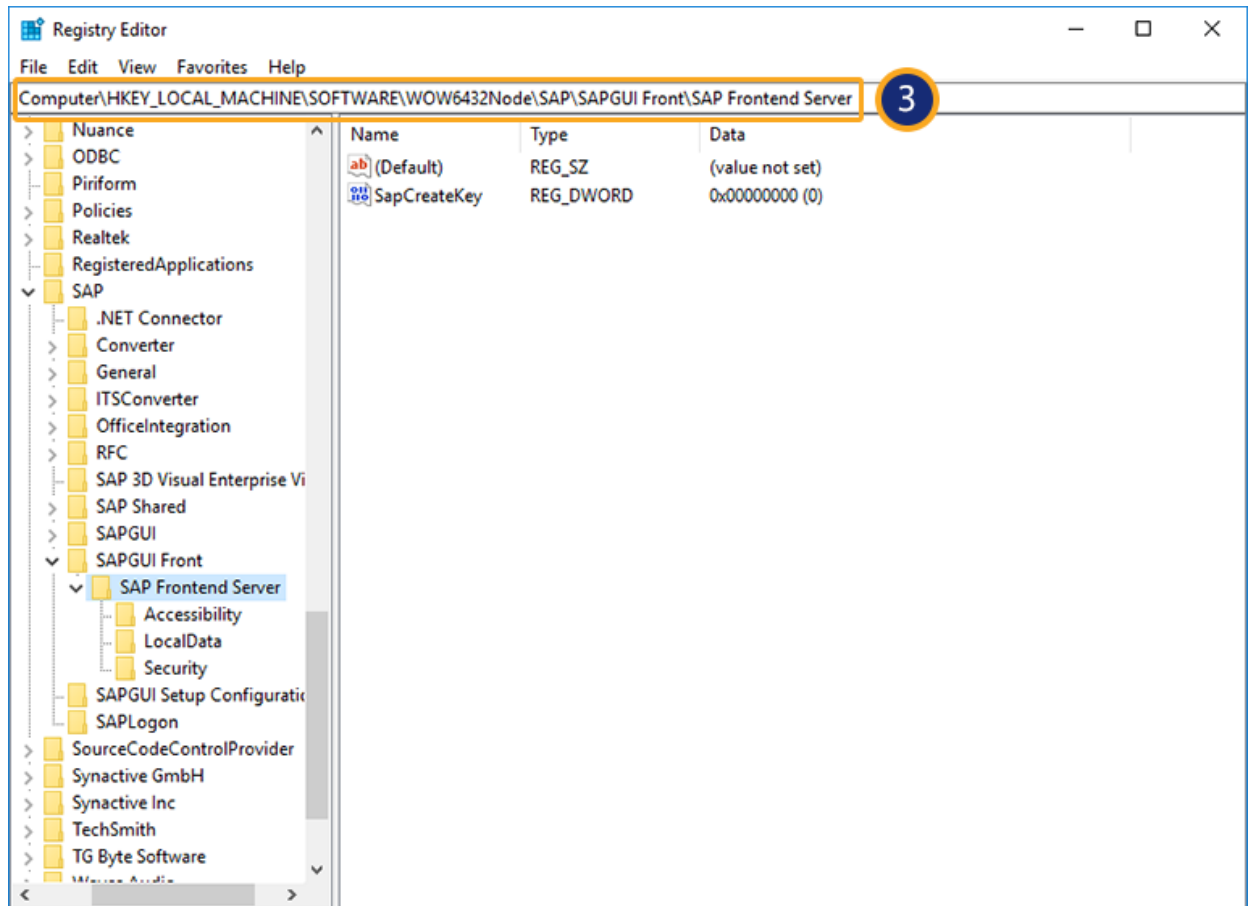


2. You can view the Registry Editor and open the HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE folder.



3. Navigate to the below specified path to create a registry key.

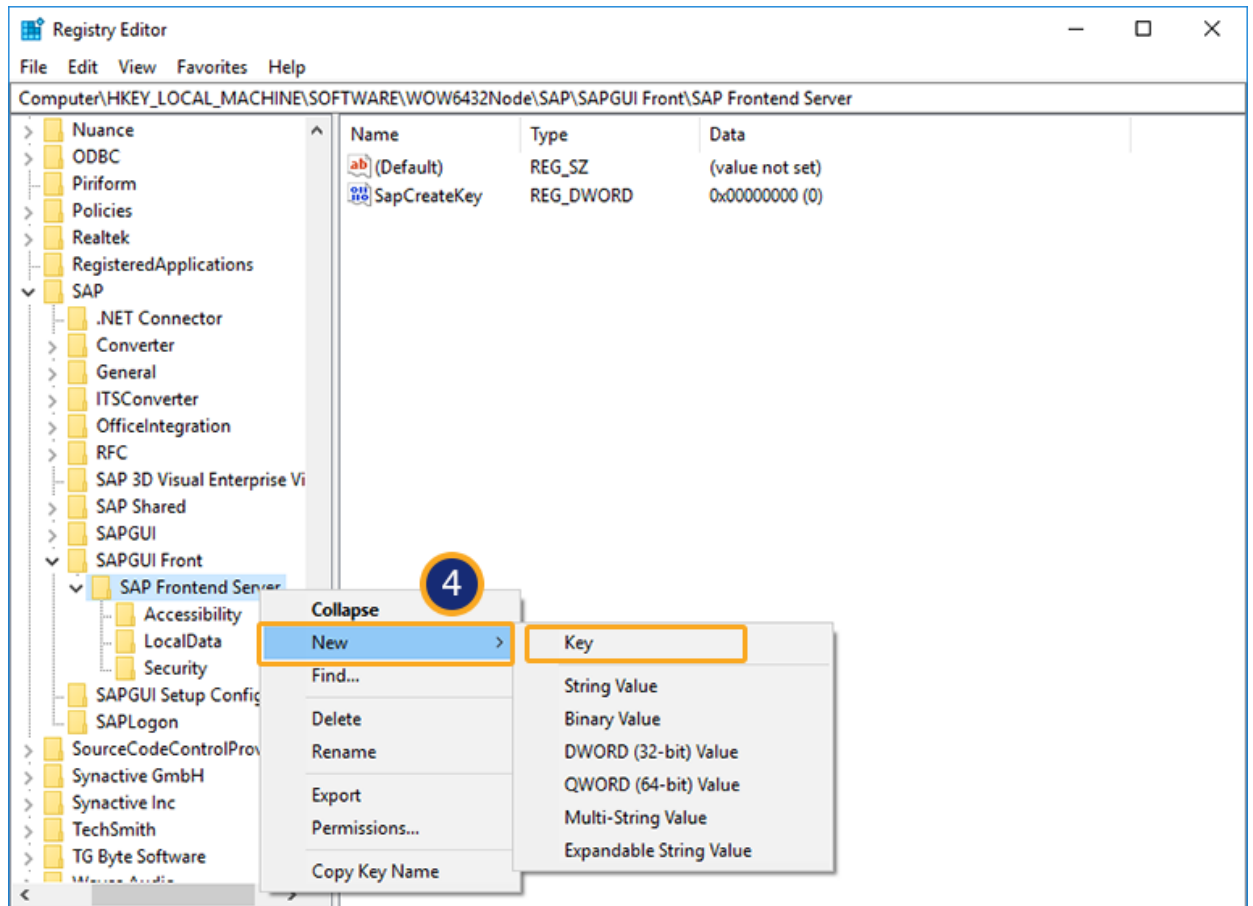
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HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Wow6432Node\SAP\SAPGUI Front\SAP Frontend Server

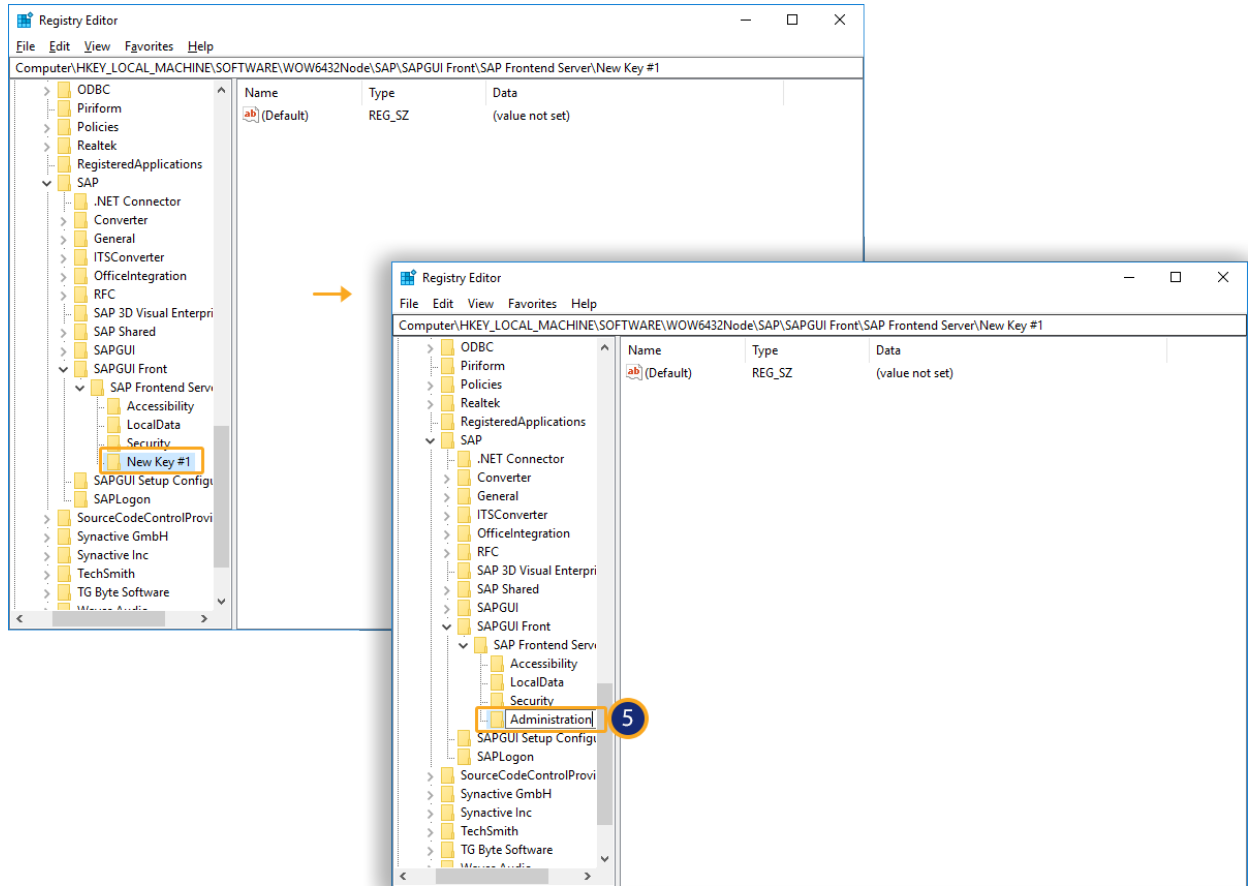
4. Right Click on **SAP Frontend Server**, select **New** and then select **Key**.

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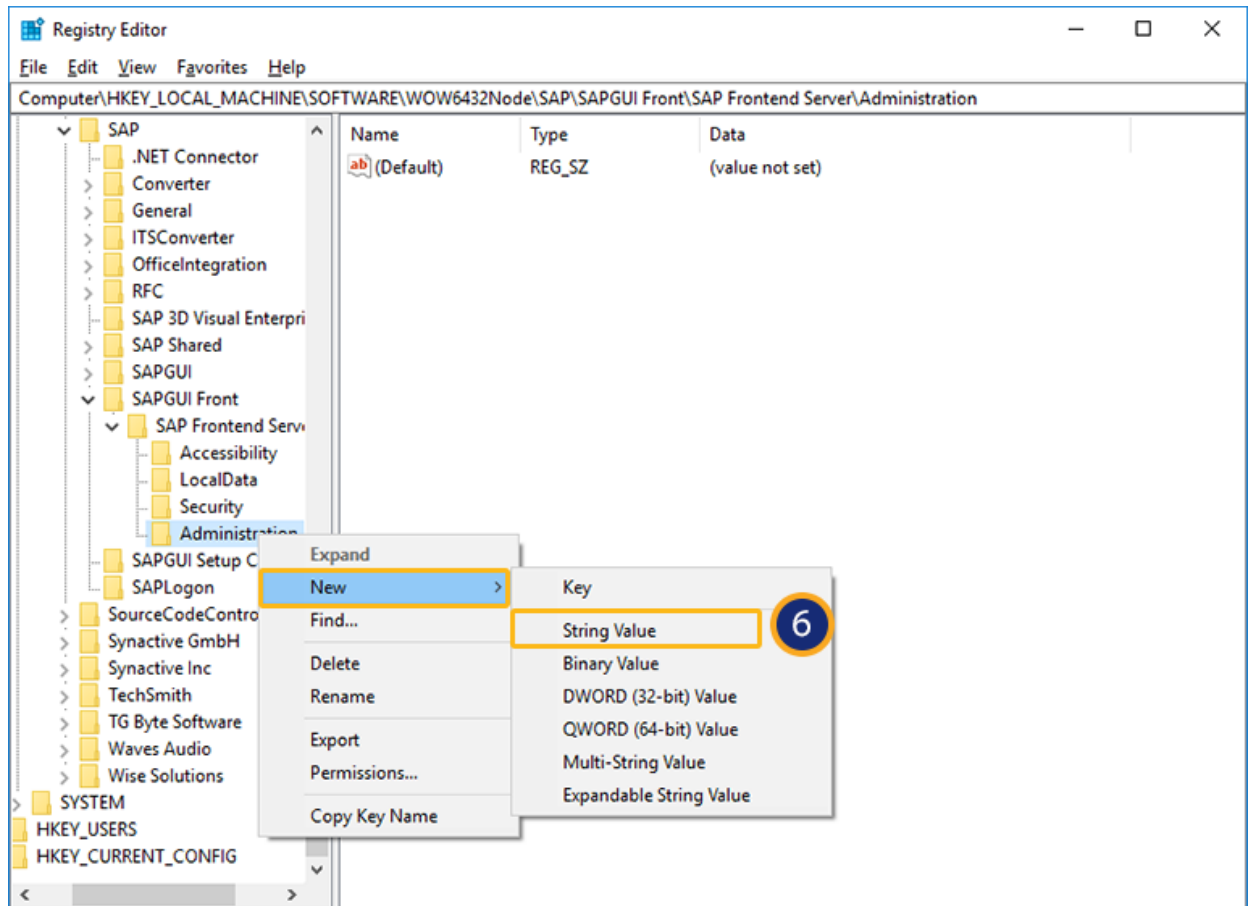
5. You need to rename **New Key #1** to **Administration**.

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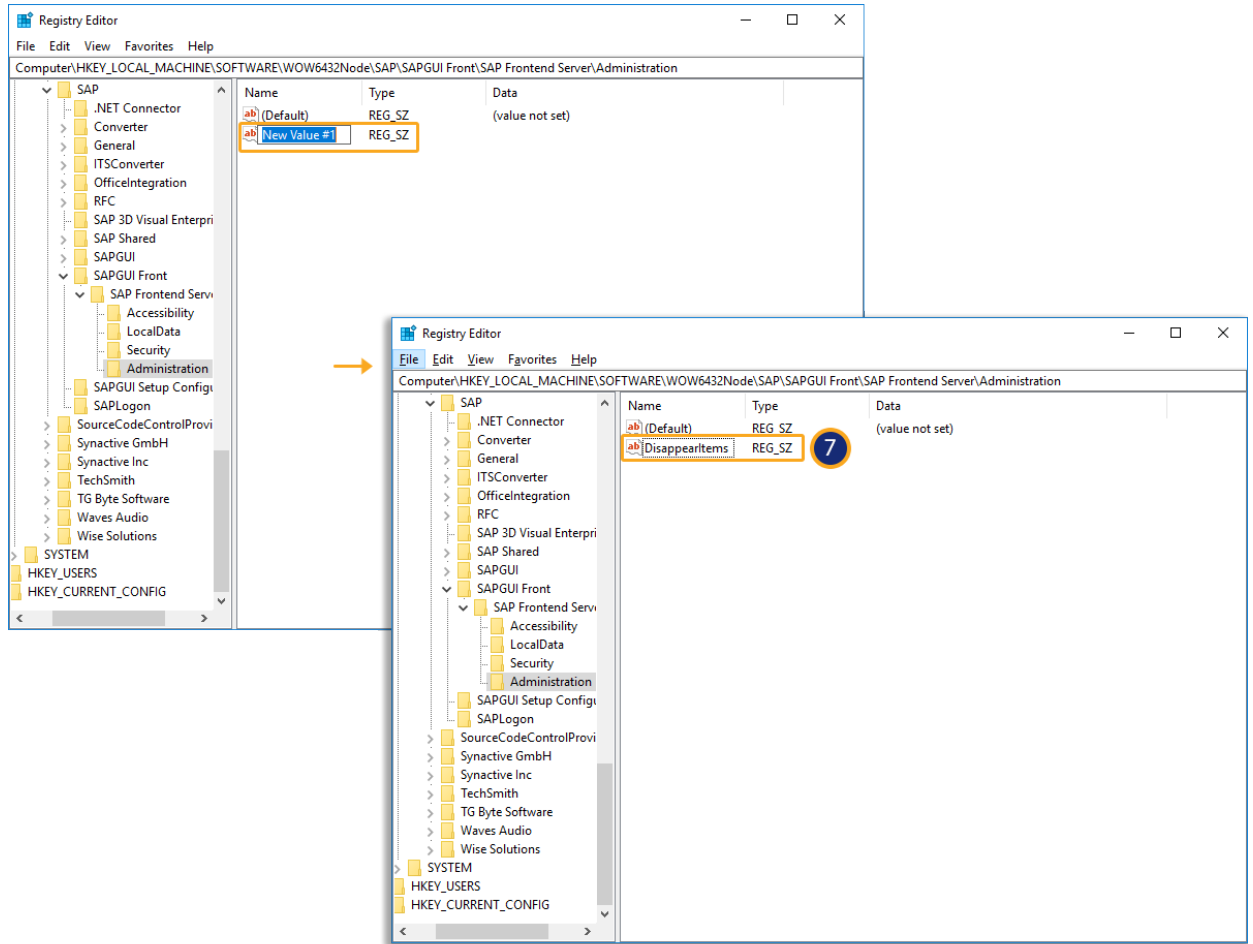
6. Right Click on **Administration** Key and select **New**, and then select **String Value**.
