3.03 Hide Activate GuiXT in SAP GUI

Purpose

You can hide **Activate GuiXT** menu Item in SAP GUI using registry key and value in [32Bit Operating System](#) and [64Bit Operating System](#).

Pre-requisites:

1. You need to have Administrative rights for the machine on which the task is to be performed.
2. Close all SAP GUI instances including the SAPLogon Pad.
3. [Create a New Registry Key.](#)

Steps to hide Activate GuiXT Registry Key (Administration) for 32Bit Operating System.

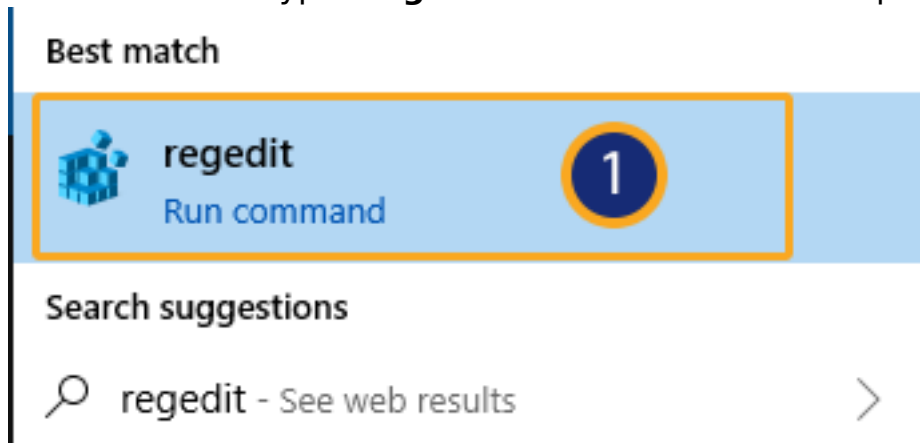
1. Click "**start**", type "**regedit**" in the search bar and run as an administrator.
2. Navigate to the below specified path to create a registry key.

HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\\Software\\SAP\\SAPGUI Front\\SAP Frontend Server\\Administration

3. Double Click on the DisappearItems field and you will see a popup window as shown below:
4. Enter "**Activate GuiXT**" in the **Value Data** field and click **OK**.
5. Open **SAP GUI** and you will find "**Activate GuiXT**" menu item under Customize Layout settings tab is dissapeared..

Steps to hide Activate Guixt(Administration) for 64Bit Operating System.

1. Click **Start** and type "**regedit**" in the search bar and press enter.



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2. Navigate to the below specified path to create a registry key.

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HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Wow6432Node\SAP\SAPGUI Front\SAP Frontend Server\Administration

3. Double Click **DisappearItems** field and you will see a popup window as shown below:

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4. Enter “**Activate GuiXT**” in the **Value Data** field and click **OK**.

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5. Open **SAP GUI** and you will find "**Activate GuiXT**" menu item under Customize Layout settings tab is dissapeared.
