1.07 What are different Liquid UI for Android pricing models?

Liquid UI for Android offers a subscription base pricing model. The following frequently asked questions will help you understand its pricing model.

What are the different pricing models?

You can buy the Liquid UI for Android App license using one of the two options listed as follows:

- 1. **Subscription base**, In-App-Purchase through the Google Play store. The subscription lets you use the app on either a monthly or yearly basis. The month is calculated from the day you buy the app.
- 2. **Purchase through Liquid UI Sales**, recommended for bulk licenses at a discounted price.

How does the Liquid UI for Android subscriptions work?

You can choose a subscription for 30 days or 365 days (12 months) through the In-App purchase. A 30 days subscription is valid for 30 calendar days, which means if you buy it on the 10th of the month, it will be valid until the 9th of the next month. By default, subscriptions are not renewed automatically.



Note: Purchasing the license through LAMP is recommended for more flexible buying options.

How do I choose a pricing model?

You will get an enterprise license with the pricing model. Enterprise license lets you connect to the SAP Server using the Liquid UI for Android. Obtain an Enterprise license using the following two ways.

- 1. Purchase through the Google Play store
- 2. Purchase through the Liquid UI Access Management Portal

To help you choose the most suitable subscription, we have created a comparison table between purchases through the Google Play store and purchases through the Liquid UI and Access Management Portal.
